### TECHNICAL DATA

<b>Appellation</b>	DO Jumilla
<b>Winemaker</b>	Pilar Abellán
<b>Winery</b>	Viña Elena
<b>Vineyards</b>	17 hectares of 13 year old and old vines, 500 metres above sea level, set within the semi-arid, hilly landscape of northern Murcia in the south-west of Spain, producing full-flavoured, well-coloured grapes which in turn produce wines full of character.
<b>Varietals</b>	85% Monastrell, 10% Shiraz and 5% Cabernet Sauvignon
<b>Winemaking</b>	The grapes were hand harvested from 8 years old vines, which were fermented in stainless steel tanks. The grapes were macerated for 10-12 days to extract maximum colour.
<b>Ageing</b>	4 months in 2 year old, lightly toasted French oak barrels.

<b>Total acidity</b>	4.9g/l (tartaric)
<b>Vol acidity</b>	0.54 g/l (acetic)
<b>PH</b>	3.8
<b>Resid. sugar</b>	4.7 g/l

<b>Colour</b>	Very well coloured and bright.
<b>Nose</b>	Cherry and red fruit on the nose.
<b>Palate</b>	Rich and velvety with a long finish.
