TECHNICAL DATA

Appellation	D.O. Campo de Borja
Winemakers	Fernando Mora and Roberto Pérez
Vineyards	Old bush vines of more than 25 years of age in the area of Aragón known as the “Empire of Garnacha”. The vines grow at 500-600 metres of altitude, mainly on un-irrigated parcels of distinctive rusty-red stony ferrous soil, with some stony, chalky parcels adding complexity. Very low yields of max. 4,400kg/ha. The grapes are harvested by hand.
Varietals	100% garnacha.
Winery	Founded in 1945 in Ainzón (Zaragoza) it is one of the longest standing small wineries in the area. Garnacha specialists (72% of production), they combine traditional winemaking expertise with the latest technology.
Ageing	20% of the wine is aged for 6 months in new French oak barrels, the rest is stored in concrete tanks.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Colour	Vibrant cherry red with purple highlights.
Nose	Intensely aromatic nose in which floral notes stand out over ripe red fruits, dried figs and spices.
Palate	Minerality, elegance and freshness combine in this unique wine, with a smooth, silky mouth feel and a fruit-filled finish.
