- Named after a little known high vineyard area where the soil is so poor that only grapevines, olive groves and hazelnut trees thrive.
- The Mediterranean climate gives great fruit intensity.
- A unique, personalized bottle at a great price giving fantastic shelf stand-out.
- Premium Tempranillo with 13% abv and a crisp Airén-Sauvignon Blanc blend



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Airén-Sauvignon Blanc

- 60% Airén and 40% Sauvignon Blanc
- A brilliant pale straw coloured wine with greenish tinges and a crystalline aspect.
- Fresh and fruity aromas of apple and pear.
- Crisp and fruity with a well-balanced creamy texture. Particularly refreshing and dry.

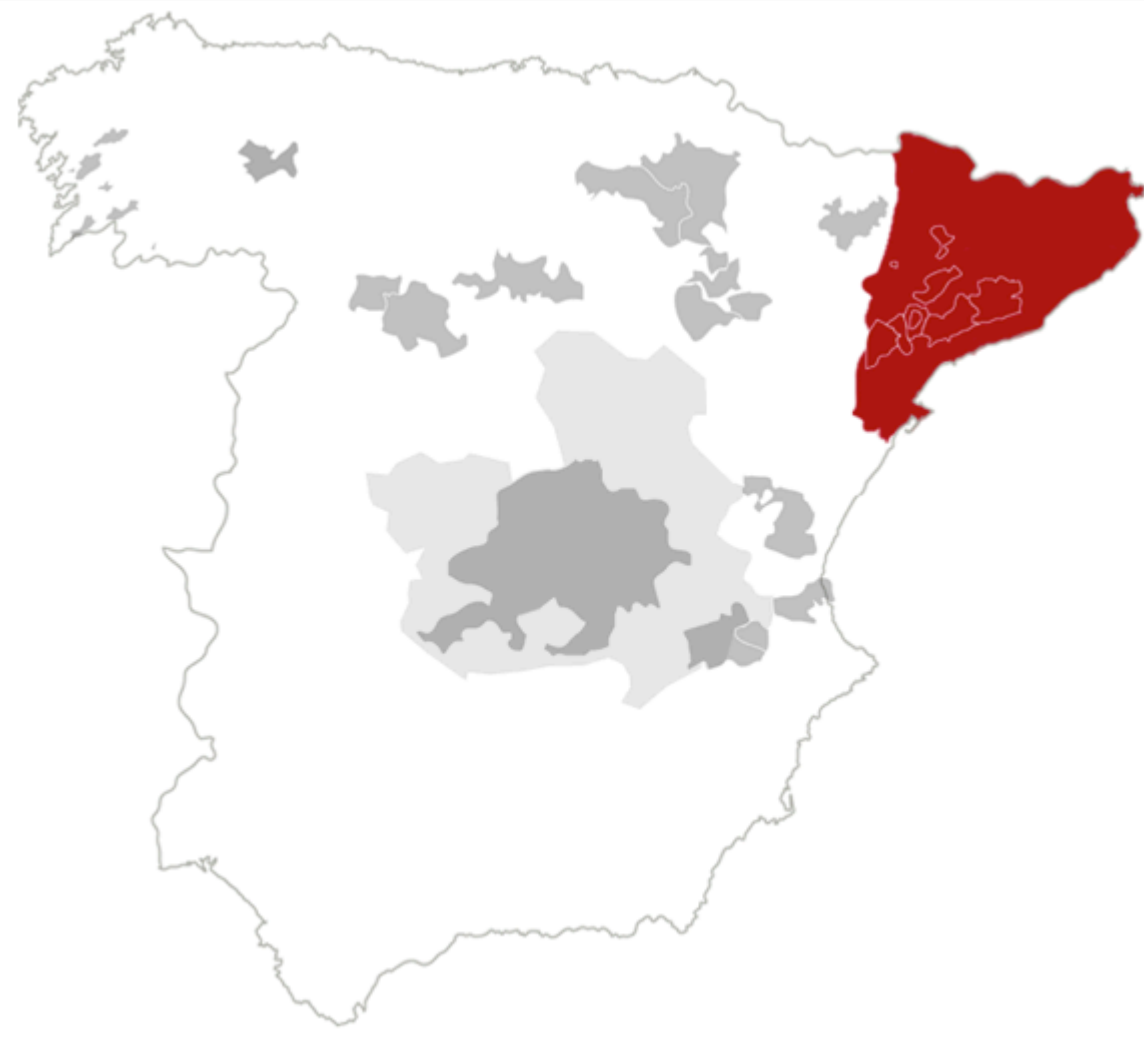


Tempranillo

- 100% Tempranillo.
- Appealing brilliant cerise with purple highlights.
- Intense aroma of cherry fruit, combined with blueberries and a touch of liquorice.
- On the palate, the wine sings with fruit with a velvety mouth feel.
- Un-oaked to preserve the fruit flavours

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Where it comes from

- VINO de España is a catch-all term that gives the winemaker greater flexibility and the consumer great value for money.
- It permits wine to be blended from grapes produced anywhere in Spain.
- In practice, this wine is sourced from Reserva de La Tierra's vineyards across Catalonia.
- Catalonia enjoys a Mediterranean climate with plenty of sunshine and warm temperatures all year round.
- This allows grapes to ripen fully, accumulating colour and sugars and producing wines which are packed with fruit flavours.

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Where it comes from

- Vines on slopes between the Mediterranean sea and inland mountain ranges.
- Poor soils and dry Mediterranean conditions give intense wines with high alcohol levels, while sea breezes maintain freshness.
- Ripe grapes produced consistently and economically.

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Where it is made

- Altos d'Oliva is made at Reserva de la Tierra with input from Long Wines throughout all the winemaking process.
- Located in Les Borges del Camp, Tarragona, around 20km from the Mediterranean coast.
- Run by a family with roots in Mendoza, Argentina.
- State-of-the-art winery has 5 fully-automated production lines.

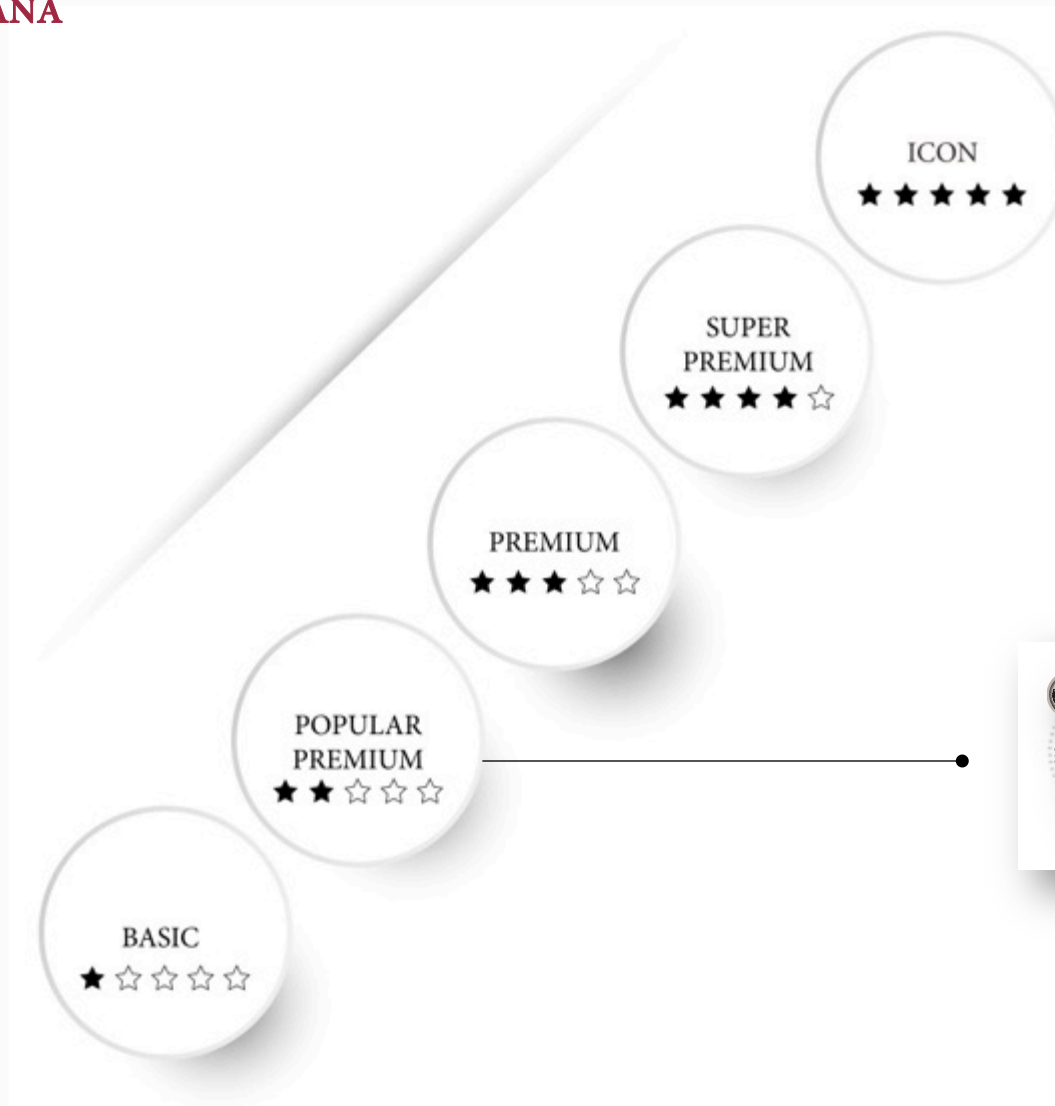
