Technical data

Appellation	DO Catalunya
Winemakers	Elias Gil
Vineyards	Set in the “high lands” of Cataluña above the River Ebro, just south of Priorat. Low-yielding vines (10,000-8,000 kilos per hectare) grown on clay soil with some chalk and stone content. Situated at 350-500 metres, the area has a Mediterranean climate with continental influence and just 350-500mm of rain.
Varietals	40% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Tempranillo, 30% Garnacha.
Winery	Family-run winery with 25 hectares - their own vineyard and long term contracts with other growers, making smaller parcels of carefully blended wines from genuine old vines.
Winemaking	Seven months in stainless steel tanks with successive rackings, before transfer to American oak barrels, where it ages for 36 months.

Winemaker's notes

 Colour	Burgundy coloured with good depth.
 Nose	Rich, varied and complex aromas of jam and forest fruits, blackberry and redcurrant against a subtle spicy backdrop of vanilla, bay and pepper.
 Palate	Full-bodied and full-flavoured with high quality tannins. Long finish with hints of tobacco and toast.
