Symbolic of Spain's natural diversity and its longest-standing traditions

- The name *Las Carlinas* refers to a type of thistle, native to Spain and with a yellow star-like flower in the centre that is associated with strength and protection
- In many parts of Spain the *carlina* thistle is hung on doors to protect the inhabitants from evil spirits and sickness
- This wine is the definitive old vine Garnacha crafted by two of Spain's most dynamic young winemakers, Fernando Mora MW and Jorge Navascues
- Low-yielding old bush vines dry-farmed at more than 700 metres altitude

The region

- DO Cariñena is home to some of Spain's oldest Garnacha vineyards.
- The best vineyards are found at 700m+ altitude.
- Continental climate with cool, dry "Cierzo" winds in the winter and Mediterranean influences in the summer.
- Extreme climate and contrast between daytime and night-time temperatures help to produce wines with good acidity, intense colour and pleasing tannins.

Where it comes from

- Vineyards in the original, highest area of Cariñena with the Garnacha at 700m+
- *Terroirs* selected especially for their suitability for each variety
- Old Garnacha vines of over 100 years of age
- Dry-farmed vineyards of pebbly soils with alluvial deposits
- Sustainable viticulture, avoiding the use of pesticides and herbicides.

- 100% Garnacha.
- Vibrant cherry red with purple highlights
- Intensely aromatic nose in which floral notes stand out over ripe red fruits, figs and spices
- Minerality, elegance and freshness combine in this unique wine, with a smooth, silky mouth feel and a fruit-filled finish

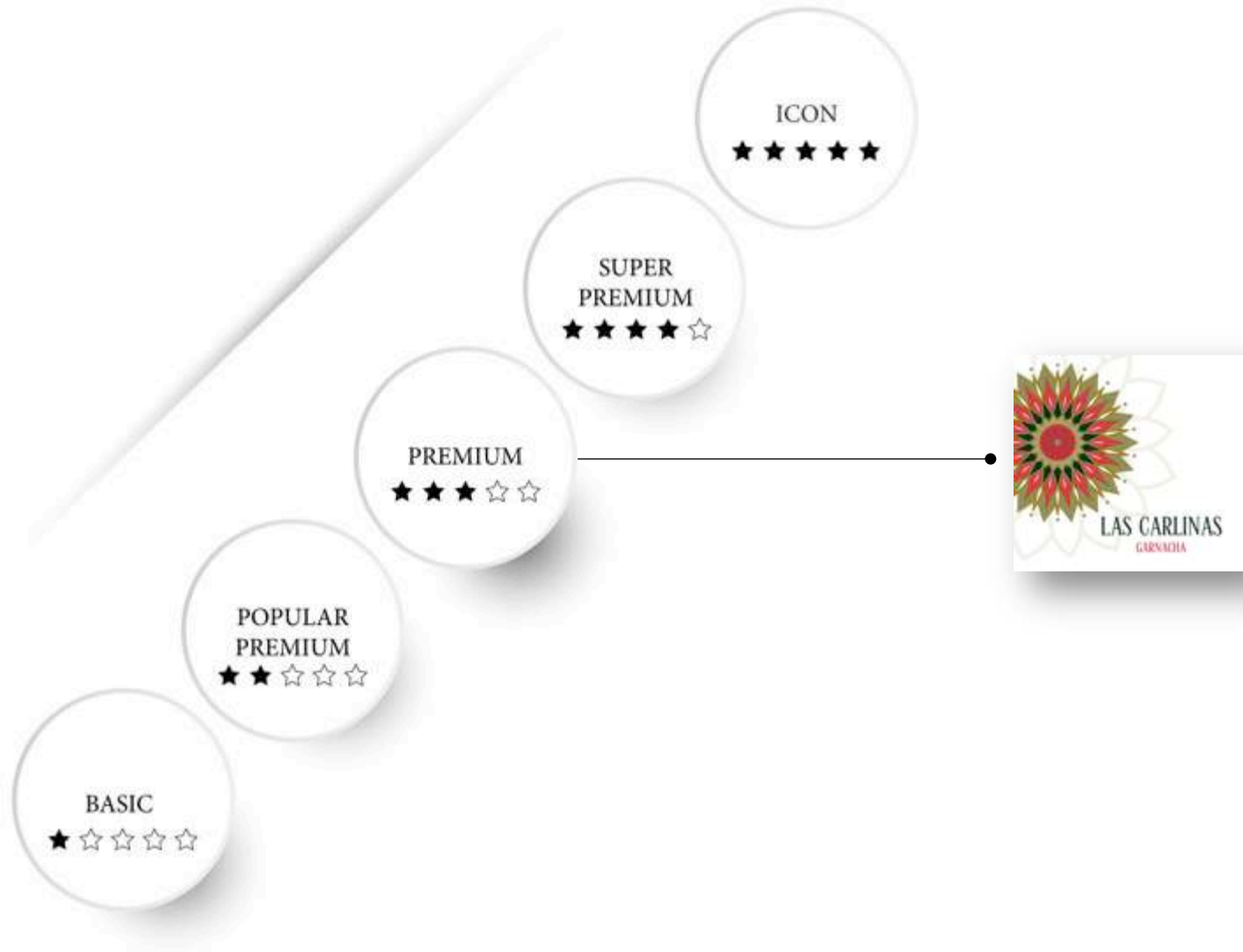
Consumers
