Vineyards	All the grapes come from the winery's own 28ha of organic vines, which grow on varied clay and limestone soils at 375-425m altitude. The grapes remain healthy due to the cleansing effect of the area's <i>cierzo</i> and <i>garbinada</i> winds, the warmth of the Mediterranean sunshine and the lack of rainfall with an average of only around 400mm per year.
Varietals	90% Garnacha Blanca / 10% Viognier
Winery	Located in Gandesa, the heart of DO Terra Alta since 1995, this family-run estate has been managed sustainably from the outset. The winery is equipped to handle 200,000kg of grapes.
Winemaking	Each of the parcels is picked and vinified separately according to its level of ripeness. The different lots are blended in the December after the harvest and then clarified, stabilised, filtered and bottled in the first months of the following year.

 Colour	Pale lemon yellow with greenish highlights.
 Nose	Clean, with tropical notes of pineapple, banana and citrus.
 Palate	Ripe, fruity and well-rounded.
