Appellation	DO Rías Baíxas
Winemaker	Marta Castro Pintos
Vineyards	Made from old vines (more than 35 years old), grown in the Salnés valley at 3 metres above sea level, with granitic and sandy soils. Yields of 8,000-9,500kg/ha.
Varietals	100% Albariño
Winery	One of the oldest family wineries in the Salnés valley, the heart of the region, in the hands of the fourth generation of the Pintos family, making wines in their "Casa Natal" – the home of their birth.
Winemaking	Fully ripened grapes are handpicked in 18 kg crates. De-stemmed grapes are macerated at 8°C for 12 hours and then gently pressed. Must is fermented in stainless steel vats where the wine rests and is stabilized before bottling.

Winemaker's notes

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Alcohol

(Colour Straw yellow colour with golden highlights. Clean, fresh citrus and stone fruit Nose aromas with notes of pastry. Palate Fresh on the palate, balanced, firm and with good acidity. Fresh and harmonious it has a powerful, long lingering finish with a hint of salinity. Analysis
